

ECI/EPCS Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Privacy Policy outlines the information that is collected and how it is used. For the purposes of this policy all references to “company” refer to Electrical Consultants, Inc. (ECI) and EPC Services Company (EPCS) hereinafter referred to as “Company”.

Information We Collect

The Personal Data that we collect may include, but is not limited to, the following categories as outlined in the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA):

- **Category I: Professional or employment-related information.**
- **Category J: Non-public education information**
- **Category K: Inferences drawn from other personal information.**

While interacting with the Company you may be asked for Personally Identifiable Information (PII) including, but not limited to:

- Name, email address, phone number, mailing address, and other contact information
- Detailed company information
- Business affiliations
- Experience or past employment

Some of the information collected from you may happen automatically as a result of utilizing technology, websites or other platforms for business purposes or visiting our facilities.

Children’s Privacy

Our website is not designed for children, we do not knowingly collect information from any person under the age of 13.

Use of Information

PII is used as necessary to offer employment, solicit business and provide services including, but not limited to the following:
